Unfortunately, there were almost no assets and the operators of the Debtor repeatedly threatened to convert to Chapter 7. Nevertheless, after some relatively intense negotiations, a plan was confirmed and FEI is going to get paid 30% of their claim over the next 5 years. FEI voted in favor of the plan. Note, in this case, Akerman represents the unsecured creditors committee, of which FEI is a part. For this reason only a BKC case number is provided. Claim amount is \$53,793.90. FEI ultimately prevailed on that action by achieving a final summary judgment against WW Lumber. After obtaining summary judgment, FEI obtained a large judgment against WW Lumber for its costs and attorneys' fees. FEI was involved in the process of obtaining discovery in aid of execution of that judgment at the time it filed bankruptcy. In fact, just prior to bankruptcy, FEI obtained a discovery order requiring WW Lumber to produce information on its finances. WW Lumber did produce a box of financial documents, but still owes FEI some additional financial information pursuant to the discovery order. The next step would be to pursue that outstanding information and review the information that has already been produced. The judgments and order I reference are attached. \$500K was awarded for attorney's fees in this action.	500,000.00
